Chandra told of her introduction to life in England and how she had to get used to our 4 seasons of weather compared to her upbringing in tropical Malaysia and recalled many amusing tales. Girls and boys in Malaysia have to learn Batik from the age of 14 until they are 17 and their training is very strict. At the end of their training they have to produce a cotton batik work and a silk batik work and the boys also have to do bamboo work.

We were shown some wonderful examples of both sorts of batik and Richard

demonstrated how to do a silk batik work using the hot wax. A very entertaining evening.
